

HOW DOES THE EXAMINATION TAKE PLACE?

RECEPTION AND PRODUCTION

The examinations were created to include the four communication skills at every level, with varying degrees of interaction and mediation required depending on the level.



To obtain a diploma, it is necessary to pass each of the four corresponding sections and obtain a minimum of 50 out of 100.

ASSESSMENT

Oral examinations take place individually and are conducted by two assessors trained by authorized experts, thus ensuring worldwide uniform standards of evaluation worldwide. Every paper is corrected twice by different assessors.

TOPICS

The exam topics are pre-tested by the French Embassy in India in order to reflect the linguistic and cultural diversity in the world.

DEL F JUNIOR



The DELF junior is a special version in which themes used are chosen to suit preadolescent and adolescent candidates. These diplomas are structured in the same way as the other versions, and the level assessed is the same.
